2022 ADELANTO CHRISTMAS PARADE

Parade Rules:

By submitting this application, all applicants are deemed as having agreed to abide by the following parade rules and the direction of parade officials. The Adelanto Christmas Parade reserves the right to exclude or expel any participants from the parade for violation or infraction of the rules.

Application Deadline: November 28, 2022, by 6:00 p.m.

- Please fill out the *Entry Form* accurately and completely. Fill out the *Parade Announcer Sheet*- giving a description of your float; write it as you would like it to be read on television. For example...entry number 40 is sponsored by the Lions Club and was decorated by the team and their family members.
- We ask that you don't enter trucks with an undecorated bed or trailer full of just people as a float entry. **Decorate, decorate, and decorate!!** This is a Christmas parade. We also ask that companies decorate their company vehicles.
- All participants must be appropriately attired, and appropriate language used in the floats.
- **Entry forms** must be received no later than **November 28, 2022**. The final line-up will be planned the weekend before the parade. All entries will be contacted. Please return your *Entry Form* as soon as possible so we can work on line-up.
- All entries will be given a line-up number. The driver of your entry **MUST** know the line-up number. This number **MUST** be posted on the passenger side door of the vehicle. We will furnish these numbers to you on the day of the parade, please check in no later than 8:30 a.m. **REMINDER:** please indicate on the entry form the number of people/cars in your float, so that we can make the appropriate space needed for you at the line-up. Example: Need a car length or etc.
- Please inform the parents of all children involved that after 8:30 a.m. on December 10, 2022, **NO VEHICLES** will be allowed in the staging area if they are not directly in the parade. This means that parents will not be allowed to drive their children back to their float site: they will have to walk. This may seem like an inconvenience, but it is for the safety of all involved.
- The parade route is approximately 1 mile long. Entries must keep moving during the parade to prevent back-ups and uneven spacing of the entries along the route. All entries must always keep a forward motion. **NO STOPPING TO ENTERTAIN.** There will be an opportunity to perform in front of the Parade judges which is marked off; groups may perform if they can do so and still walk at parade speed. Any violation of this rule will cause the participant to be disqualified next year.
- Please have plenty of adult supervision if your float involves many children. Please keep them in your assigned float area.

- No alcohol consumption or drug use is allowed at any time.
- For all entries with live animals, please make sure to indicate the total number of animals in your entry. If you can provide someone to clean up after them, then please do so.
- Please try to carpool to your float site and have as few of vehicles as possible in the staging area. We will be using every bit of parking for the float line-up, which leaves no room for extra vehicles. If a vehicle is parked in another floats space, you will be asked to move it.
- All parade floats, with full cast and crew, must line up on Aster Road, South of Seneca Road, by 8:30 a.m. All roads to the site will be closed at 9:00 a.m. to begin clearing the roads for the parade. Marching bands will also begin to arrive at 9:00 a.m. Please keep your group organized and together to limit confusion.
- **Floats with performers and Bands will be judged during the parade at the Judges Staging Area. They will have 3 minutes to perform.**
- At 10:00 a.m., the main event will begin. The Grand Marshal will do the honorary kickoff for the parade.
- To avoid confusion, the City of Adelanto reserves the right to have the **ONLY Santa Claus** in the Christmas Parade. Santa will make his arrival at the end of the parade, and no other Santa will be allowed on any float or with any marching group.
- **No objects may be thrown from your entry along the parade route, but members of your entry may walk along the sidelines and distribute handouts or candy.**
- The results will be announced on the City's website, Facebook Page, and the Adelanto Bulletin Display.
- Absolutely no music containing explicit lyrics, which include depictions of violence and sex, will be allowed to be played any time before, during or after the parade. Violation of this rule will be enforced on the day of the parade by excusing the participant and by exclusion for future parades.
- Certificates/Prize Winnings: Certificates and Monetary Prize Winnings for winning entries will be awarded January 25, 2023 - 7:00 p.m. in the Adelanto City Council Chambers.
- If you have any questions, please contact us as soon as possible. We reserve the right to reject any entry that does not meet 2022 parade requirements. You can contact Virginia Cervantes or Brenda Lopez at (760) 246-2300 ext. 11124 or 11123.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT AND WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I [First and Last Name] _____ desire to volunteer at the City of Adelanto's ("City") Christmas Parade ("Event") scheduled for December 10, 2022. In consideration of being permitted to participate as a volunteer in the Event and to use any City facilities in connection with the Event, I agree to the following:

1. I understand and acknowledge that I am participating in the Event as a Participant and not as an employee, agent, official, officer, or representative of the City. I further acknowledge that I am not entitled to any compensation, benefit, or insurance coverage from the City or any Event promoter, sponsor, or organizer.
2. **Assumption of Risk:** I understand that there are risks of injury, death, damage or theft of personal property associated with volunteering for the Event. I am not aware of any physical, mental, or other health limitation that would prevent me from safely participating in this Event. If I do not feel that I can perform an assigned task, I assume the responsibility of informing City staff overseeing the Event. In consideration for being allowed to participate in the Event, I hereby assume the risk of, and responsibility for, any such injury, death or damage which I may sustain arising out of or in any way connected with performance of services as a volunteer at the Event, including injury, death or damage resulting from any acts or omissions, whether negligent or not, or any property or equipment owned or supplied by or on behalf of the City, its officials, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and any other promoters, operators or co-sponsors of the Event.
3. **Release and Waiver:** In consideration for being allowed to participate in the Event as a participant, I hereby release, waive, discharge, and agree not to sue the City, and the Adelanto Community Benefit Corporation and their respective employees, elected and appointed officials, officers, agents, volunteers, and representatives (collectively, "Releasees"), from any and all liability, claims, or causes of action arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in the Event as a Participant, or the Releasees acts or omissions, whether negligent or not ("Waiver"). I agree to this Waiver on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns.

4. **Indemnification:** I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releases, from any and all claims for compensation, judgments, expenses and attorneys' fees, personal injury, property damage or wrongful death caused by my negligence or willful misconduct, while Participating at the Event ("Indemnification"). I agree to this Indemnification on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns.
5. **Injury:** I hereby release the City from any claim that may arise as a result of any first aid treatment or other medical services that I receive in connection with my service as a Participant with the City. If I am injured during the Event, I authorize any physician licensed in California to provide the emergency treatment he or she believes, in his or her sole judgment is necessary. I also fully understand that the City does not assume any responsibility for or have any obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability insurance, in the event of injury, illness, death or property damage.
6. **Photos or Recordings:** I agree to allow my image "or likeness," or that of my minor child, to be used in published materials and web sites that promote City events or program. I grant the City all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images, video or audio recordings and other replications or documentation of my person or voice made by the City while serving as a Participant during the Event, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits that are derived from such photographs or recordings.

I expressly agree that the foregoing Waiver, Indemnification and assumption of risk are intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by California law and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the remaining provisions shall continue in full legal force and effect.

I have carefully read the foregoing Agreement and fully understand its contents and legal consequences, including that it prevents me from suing the Releasees, including the City or its employees, agents, or officers, if I am injured or damaged for any reason as a result of my participation in the Event as volunteer. I further represent and warrant that I have signed this Agreement of my own free will, under no duress or threat of duress, without any inducement, promise or guarantee being communicated to me.
